

Echo Town are a two piece band with a sizeable drum kit, three guitars, a didgeridoo and a djembe. Despite having only two members their setup can dominate a small stage. The drum kit can reluctantly be minimised if the space is tight. Alternatively the stage plan (see next page) can be altered accordingly.

Load in, set up and sound check time required: 1.5 hours minimum

Please provide a minimum of two monitors, one for each band member, on separate mixes. The band also requires a sound engineer if using a PA provided by the venue or third party.

If the venue cannot provide a PA or engineer please inform the band so they can bring their own gigging PA (not suitable for larger venues).

The guitar amp is generally placed behind the drums between the performers so that it can be heard by both. Please mic up if possible or line out to the PA as required.

The band can provide two microphones and additional cables if need be.
